383. Apologies

Cllr. Pengelly sent his apology. The Council accepted his apology.

384. Declaration of Matters of Interest

Cllr. Lamb declared an interest in Planning Application 4034/22/HHO, as he knows the owners of the property.

Cllr. Russell reported there have been three near misses on the road from Broad Park Road to Tuckermarsh. The speed limit is 60 mph but how can the Council request it be reduced to 30 mph, or have SLOW marked on the road? Cllr. Lamb proposed the Clerk organise a site visit between the County Councillor, Cllr. Philip Sanders, the Local Devon Highways Officer and concerned members of the public to discuss the issue further. Seconded by Cllr. Maycock.

The Tuckermarsh road sign is also pointing the wrong way. The Clerk to report to Devon Highways and request it be rectified.

Cllr. Crozier updated the Committee that the electric car charging points for Pilgrim Drive are scheduled to be installed in approx. three/four months' time.

390. Highways & HATOC updates

Regarding adding The Down to the gritting route, the Clerk read out an email from the Local Devon Highways Officer: 'I have spoken to our winter service manager and they have stated that 'Unfortunately we are unable amend or add to this route as this does not meet our criteria for treatment.' The Highways Officer therefore suggests that the Council purchase a grit bin from Devon Highways, approve its location and Highways would then take over the maintenance of refilling it. The Clerk has requested the cost of purchasing a grit bin and also the criteria for adding a road to the gritting route.

Cllr. Lamb proposed submitting a request through the Freedom of Information Act, to obtain the cost of gritting the villages roads. Seconded by Cllr. Maycock.

391. Discussion on renaming one of the Station Roads in Bere Ferrers

It was discussed by the Council a few years ago, that one of the roads be renamed to New Zealander Way, but the residents at the time were 50/50 to renaming the road.

Cllr. Lamb proposed writing letters to the residents to canvass support for the road name change and if there is enough support, the Council to forward the request to Devon County Council. Seconded by Cllr. Maciejowska.
