TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR THE FOOTPATHS AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE

These rules are supplemental to, and do not in any way override, The Parish Council's standing orders &/or financial regulations.

- 1. The Footpaths and Environment Committee will be constituted of 6 members of Council with the Chair of Council as an ex-officio member.
- 2. Members will be elected at the Annual General Meeting.
- 3. The Chair and Vice-Chair of the Committee will be chosen by the Members of the Committee.
- 4. The Committee will meet every three months.
- 5. The Committee shall work to maintain the footpaths in the Parish through the Parish Paths Partnership.
- 6. Members of the Committee should develop an awareness of the state of the footpaths and should do their best to walk them on a regular basis.
- 7. The Committee will monitor the environment within its Parish boundaries. This may include such things as waster bins, dog fouling, winter provision and any other topic relevant to the environment.
- 8. The Committee will regularly check their balance sheet and ensure that the precept money and any grant funds are accounted for.
- 9. Any matter which is decided upon by a unanimous vote of those present at the meeting and not having any financial implications, may be actioned at once.
- 10. The Committee will be responsible for the production of the Footpath Guide.
